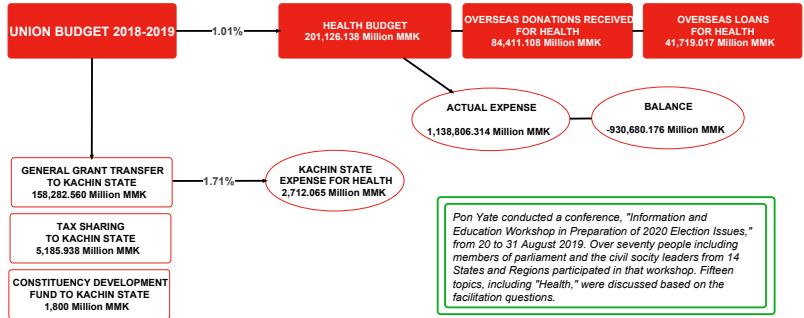




HEALTH INFORMATION IN KACHIN STATE



Findings and Recommendations from the Workshop

- The budget is insufficient for the needs of the community.
- Not enough healthcare workers. Community forced to rely upon military doctors.
- The system is helping the military, not the community.
- Public healthcare is inadequate, private healthcare is too expensive.
- Need more educational opportunities to provide qualified healthcare professionals.
- Inefficient/insufficient healthcare budget. An abundance of funds are going to providing new buildings, some of which should be transferred to acquiring better medication and tools.
- Some health departments should be combined
- Need a policy for international donations.
- Need transparency at all levels.
- Need health insurance.
- Need to provide educational opportunities for the public.
- Need a policy for malpractice incidents.

Pon Yate conducted a conference, "Information and Education Workshop in Preparation of 2020 Election Issues," from 20 to 31 August 2019. Over seventy people including members of parliament and the civil society leaders from 14 States and Regions participated in that workshop. Fifteen topics, including "Health," were discussed based on the facilitation questions.
