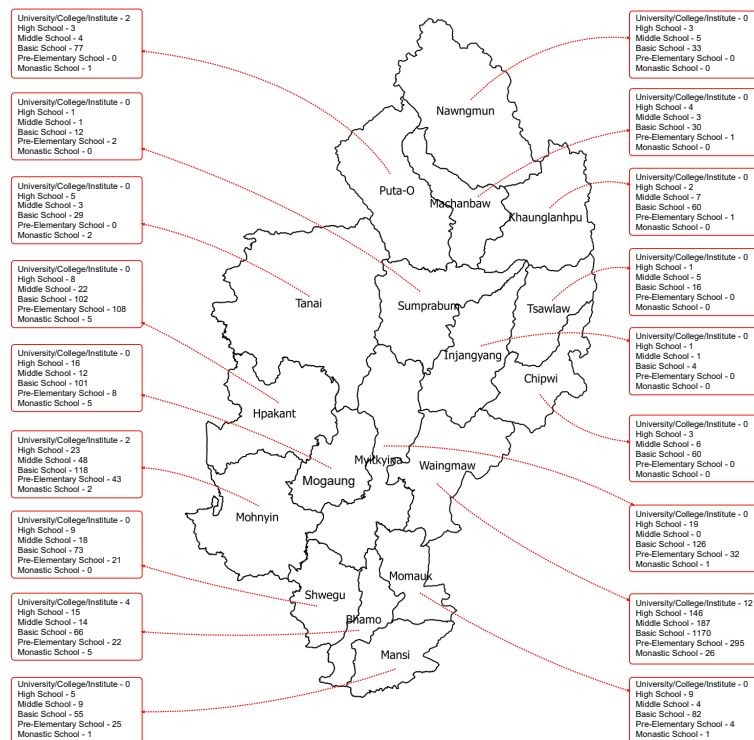


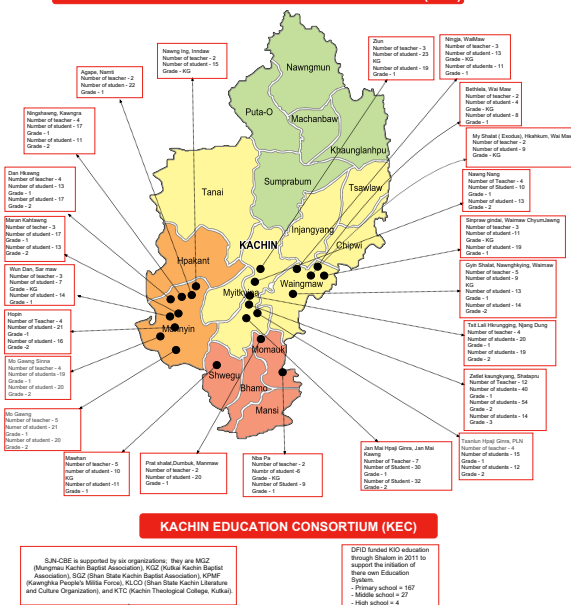


- Need to develop a mother-tongue based curriculum.
- There's no systematic budget policy for Kachin State because the education budget is managed by the Union Ministry of Social Welfare and Resettlement, so the state budget for education is not sufficient.
- The Government should recognize community schools and draft laws to support them
- Improve government schools to produce more qualified students that can compete with private schools. As part of the improvement, government schools should also build networks with private schools.
- Need to reform the education law to be a sustainable educational system.
- Need to reform school committees to make parents and the community aware of the importance of education and to encourage students to better understand their interests for furthering their studies.
- The Government should explore the reasons behind providing tutoring instead of punishing teachers.
- Entrance for higher education should not be decided by scores, but by the students' interests.
- To avoid 'brain drain', the Ministry of Education should provide a career-based curriculum that supports building capacity in the country.
- Education officers should be aware of not only the procedures but also how to reform the system.
