


## **EDUCATION INFORMATION IN MON STATE**



## Findings and Recommendations from the workshop

- Mother-tongue education-based curriculum system, inclusive of multiple languages (including neighboring countries' languages).
- •Need transparency on the education budget at the State and Regional levels.
- Decentralized education policy
- •The Government should acknowledge community schools and support their budget.
- Need research and assessment of the advantages and disadvantages of tuition.
- Increase teachers' salaries.
- The Government should make parents and the community aware of the importance of education, as well as ethnic education. The Government needs to provide more education on policy and laws.

**INFORMAL EDUCATION IN MON STATE** 

- Entrance for higher education should not be decided by scores, but by the students' interests.
- Need university curriculum reform to better support job opportunities.

In addition to MORA, monastic schools are supported by MOE, INGOs, NGOs and private donations. There are more than 1,500 monastic schools in Myanmar.
